## Many say they 'KNOW' Jesus, but they do not

Before we start this narrative, we want to point out that many people will say that they 'know' Jesus. Many Christians will tell you that in a heartbeat. However, the Lord Jesus Christ knows which people are His, and He is saying that many people say 'Lord, Lord' but He doesn't know them. Let's take a look at what the word 'know' means first.

To **know** is defined as follows:

verb (mainly transitive) **knows, knowing, knew** (nju:), **known** (nəʊn)

- (also intransitive; may take a clause as object) to be or feel certain of the truth or accuracy of (a fact, etc)
- **to be acquainted or familiar with**

So let us agree that to know is to:

- to be acquainted or familiar with
- to have a familiarity or grasp of, as through study or experience:
- to discriminate, distinguish
- to know by experience
- to recognise, admit, acknowledge, confess
- to consider
- to know, be acquainted with
- **to know (a person carnally)**
- to know how, be skilful in
- to have knowledge, be wise

Yes, we have highlighted to **know** to mean **intimate**.

In the Bible, you can see the word 'know' is used to describe an intimate encounter. Now, in the grander scheme of things, we can see how the Lord can 'know' a person. He explains this in the word, as seen here:

**Genesis 4:1** - And Adam **knew** Eve his wife; and she **conceived**, and bare Cain, and said, I have gotten a man from the LORD.

**Genesis 4:25** - And Adam **knew** his wife again; and she **bare a son**, and called his name Seth: For God, said she, hath appointed me another seed instead of Abel, whom Cain slew.

So what is the point of all of this?

We want to show you that when you 'know' someone, **you are intimate with them.**

- You share with them;
- you laugh with them;
- you cry with them;
- you go through with them;
- you spend time with them.



Let's say that you are a big Katy Perry fan. You have all of her CDs; you have all of her hits on your iPod. You decide to go to her concert when she is in your city. You enjoy the concert, and then you decide you want to be close to your idol, so you go backstage. When you get there, there is a burly guy standing there who stops you. He wants to know what you are doing back there. You say that you 'know' Katy and you want to see her.

Now, in this example, you have never met Katy Perry, but you know OF her. If anyone were to ask her who you were, she would not know.

Why?

It is because you have not been a part of her inner circle. You only know OF her, but she does not know you from anyone. You could be an axe murderer for all that she knows. You do NOT know her intimately. You are not family; you are not related to her; you are some person that wants to get close to her.

Most Christians are like this with Jesus. They know OF Him, but they do not know Him personally. When they die, they will call out to Jesus and He will NOT answer.

Why?

He doesn't know you intimately. This is why the Lord Jesus will say to many who will call out to Him that they know Him, and He will tell them to ['go away, I never knew you.'](#)

Can you see this, Christian?

As an aside, intercede and pray for Katy Perry, as she sold her soul to the devil, and she will go to hell and be lost without a huge outpouring of intercession from people who want her to repent and turn away from the road she is going on. By repenting, Katy Perry will be giving up her fame, her stardom, all of the money, and the 'people' around her, going back to being a modest person, but at least she will not burn in hell for eternity. She will need to beg The Lord Jesus Christ to take her back after she had walked away from Him many years ago. The devil will continue to suck the life right out of her and throw her away like an orange peel when he is done with her.



This is where most Christians get lost. Most Christians are NOT obedient to the Lord Jesus Christ. Here is why they are not obedient:

- They have **never** followed Him,
- They have **never** given their lives fully to Him.
- They have **never** obeyed His commands.
- They have **never** given their body to Jesus as a living sacrifice.
- They have **never** talked to Jesus after they went to the altar to confess their sins;
- They have **never** yielded their lives to Jesus, even though they promised they would at the altar;
- They have **never** talked to Jesus about anything;
- They have **never** consulted with Jesus about anything;
- They have **never** given up control of their lives and they run their lives as they want to, not as Jesus wanting them to.

Can you now see how Jesus doesn't know them?

Can you now see how these Christians deluded themselves into believing that they were with Jesus when they were not? This is the trap that the Once Saved, Always Saved Christians fall into. If they really knew Jesus, they could ask Him to confirm that 'Eternal Security', and they would find out real quick that 'Eternal Security' is NOT of Him. They could clear up the **Once Saved, Always Saved** debate in less than 10 minutes if they would at least talk to Jesus once in a while.

Since these Christians are 'assuming' that Jesus 'knows their heart', they are missing out, and will be in for a rude awakening when they are judged by Him. Jesus can see that their hearts are as black as soot and increasingly wicked.



As always, **take NOTHING that you have seen here in this book as the truth.** It is **YOUR responsibility to study and check out everything that you see and hear**, and you have an advocate in the Lord Jesus Christ who will help you if you would just ask Him.

Take this upon yourself, Christian, as **YOU** need to get **YOUR** Bible, **YOUR** concordance, **YOUR** dictionary, **YOUR** pens/pencils, **YOUR** notepad and then **YOU** need to seek out the Lord Jesus Christ and ask Him to help **YOU** so **YOU** can make it into His Kingdom, since it will be **YOU standing alone in front of Jesus** when **YOU** are being judged.

It is **YOUR** responsibility to make sure **YOU** are in the faith and that **YOU** have completed **YOUR** sanctification during the sanctification process and **YOU** have gotten **YOUR** forgiveness and **YOU** have repented of all of **YOUR** sins before **YOU** are judged by Jesus.

Scripture tells us that hell will enlarge itself to accommodate all of the people who will be sent there because of idols like the pope, as you can see in scripture here:

**Isaiah 5:14** - Therefore **hell hath enlarged herself, and opened her mouth without measure: and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp, and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it.**

Take this as a warning, Christian, as the Lord Jesus Christ is NOT desperate for people, as **there were only 8 people** who got on the ark before the flood, and **only 2 people** from the Hebrews from Egypt made it into the Promised Land.

Be wise, and stay IN Jesus so you are not lost.



# Have you ever heard of this teaching before, Christian?

That is OK - we know that your church has never taught you this!!

So, Christian, we will challenge you to do this - Go to Jesus directly **RIGHT NOW** and ask Him if what is shown here is true. Use this as a means to start a conversation with The Lord Jesus Christ and sit with Him and ask Him questions. Start with **(asking out loud):**

**“Jesus, is what I just read true?”**

He will answer you, Christian, and NOW you will be on the true road to salvation, knowing for **SURE** if you are going to make it or not, as Jesus would have told you. Keep talking with Him. Get to know Him and He will start to reveal Himself to you. You need to find out for yourself and work out **YOUR** salvation for **YOU**, as the scriptures tell us to.

As a part of your salvation, it is recommended that you **FORGIVE** the pastors and the churches that were sending you to hell. For many pastors, this is what they were taught in the seminary. **Many 'pastors' that pastor a church don't even know Jesus and are not authorized to be a pastor, as Jesus did not send them. Forgive them and pray for them** so they may escape damnation by repenting of their sin of misleading many people.

In closing, we want to give you an EXACT QUOTE we got from Jesus Himself:

**"Disciples of mine will make it into my Kingdom; Christians will NOT."**

Take heed, Christian, and **don't just blow this off**. What is being presented here is IMPORTANT!! Read and understand what the Lord Jesus Christ is saying to all of us. As we always say, **do not take anything we say as the gospel; ALWAYS confirm what you are reading or hearing by running it by the Lord Jesus Christ yourself**.
