



# Present Day Idol: The Rosary

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In this short book, we are going to look at the rosary and why the rosary is an idol. Just so we have a working knowledge of idolatry, let's look at what an idol is:

With that being said, an **idol** is defined as:

noun

1. a material object, esp a carved image, that is worshipped as a god
2. Christianity Judaism any being (other than the one God) to which divine honour is paid
3. a person who is revered, admired, or highly loved

We also have the origin of this word, so let's take a look at it here:

- mid-13c., "image of a deity as an object of (pagan) worship,"
- from Old French *idole* "idol, graven image, pagan god,"
- from Late Latin *idolum* "image (mental or physical), form," used in Church Latin for "false god,"
- from Greek *eidolon* "appearance, reflection in water or a mirror," later "mental image, apparition, phantom," also "material image, statue," from *eidōs* "form" (see -oid).
- Figurative sense of "something idolized" is first recorded 1560s (in Middle English the figurative sense was "someone who is false or untrustworthy"). Meaning "a person so adored" is from 1590s.

From the origins of the word, you see the words 'pagan', 'false god', 'statue', so we can correctly infer that an idol is NOT a good thing that a Christian should be looking at or dealing with. The Lord has given strict instructions about idols as you can see in scripture here:

**Leviticus 26:1** - Ye shall make you no idols nor graven image, neither rear you up a standing image, neither shall ye set up any image of stone in your land, to bow down unto it: for I am the LORD your God.

**Deuteronomy 5:9** - Thou shalt not bow down thyself unto them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me,

The devil knows this, so he sets up idols so the worship will go to HIM, as this is what he wanted from the time when iniquity was found in him. Worship means that much to the devil, and he will do anything he can to get those creations of the Lord to give HIM their worship.

So what is **worship**?

**Worship** is a public show of deep respect and devotion towards someone or something that you are in awe of/have full admiration for that you show profound, intense love and honour to in recognition of the qualities of holiness, excellence and wisdom.



In this short book, we are going to take a look at the Rosary, and then we will delve into it as being an idol that many Catholics use to help them pray. So without further ado, let's get a definition of the rosary so we will know what it is. From Wikipedia:

**The Holy Rosary** (/ˈrouzəri/; Latin: rosarium, in the sense of "crown of roses" or "garland of roses"),<sup>[1]</sup> also known as **the Dominican Rosary**, refers to a form of prayer used in the Catholic Church and to the string of knots or beads used to count the component prayers. When used for the prayer, the word is usually capitalized ("the Rosary"), as is customary for other names of prayers, such as "the Lord's Prayer", and "the Hail Mary"; when referring to the beads, it is written with a lower-case initial letter ("a rosary").

The prayers that comprise the Rosary are arranged in sets of ten Hail Marys called decades. Each decade is preceded by one Lord's Prayer and followed by one Glory Be. During recitation of each set, thought is given to one of the Mysteries of the Rosary, which recall events in the lives of Jesus and Mary. Five decades are recited per rosary. Other prayers are sometimes added before or after each decade. Rosary beads are an aid towards saying these prayers in the proper sequence.

A standard 15 Mysteries of the Rosary, based on the long-standing custom, was established by Pope Pius V during the 16th century, grouping the mysteries in three sets: the Joyful Mysteries, the Sorrowful Mysteries, and the Glorious Mysteries. During 2002 Pope John Paul II said that it is fitting that a new set of five be added,

termed the Luminous Mysteries, bringing the total number of mysteries to 20. The Glorious mysteries are said on Sunday and Wednesday, the Joyful on Monday and Saturday, the Sorrowful on Tuesday and Friday, and the Luminous Mysteries are said on Thursday. Usually five decades are recited in a session.

For more than four centuries, the rosary has been promoted by several popes as part of the veneration of Mary in Roman Catholicism, and consisting essentially in meditation on the life of Christ. The rosary also represents the Roman Catholic emphasis on "participation in the life of Mary, whose focus was Christ", and the Mariological theme "to Christ through Mary."

The rosary beads provide a physical method of keeping count of the number of Hail Marys said as the mysteries are contemplated. The fingers are moved along the beads as the prayers are recited. By not having to keep track of the count mentally, the mind is free to meditate on the mysteries. A five-decade rosary contains five groups of ten beads (a decade), with additional large beads before each decade. The Hail Mary is said on the ten beads within a decade, while the Lord's Prayer is said on the large bead before each decade. A new mystery meditation commences at each of the large beads. Some rosaries, particularly those used by religious orders, contain fifteen decades, corresponding to the traditional fifteen mysteries of the rosary. Both five- and fifteen-decade rosaries are attached to a shorter strand, which starts with a crucifix, followed by one large bead, three small beads, and one large bead, before connecting to the rest of the rosary. A five-decade rosary consists of a "total" of 59 beads.

Although counting the prayers on a string of beads is customary, the prayers of the rosary do not actually require a set of beads, but can be said using any type of counting device, by counting on the fingers or by counting without any device at all.

Where did this practice come from? Let's find out again via Wikipedia:

There are differing views on the history of the Rosary. The exact origin of the Rosary as a prayer is less than clear and subject to debate among scholars. The use of knotted prayer ropes in Christianity goes back to the Desert Fathers in the 3rd and early 4th centuries. These counting devices were used for prayers such as the Jesus prayer in Christian monasticism. The period after the First Council of Ephesus in 431 witnessed a gradual growth in the use of Marian prayers during the Middle Ages.

According to some Catholic traditions, the Rosary was given to Saint Dominic in a vision of the Blessed Virgin Mary and it was then promoted by Blessed Allan de la Roche. However, not all Catholics agree with that tradition. Some historians see a more gradual development for the Rosary, in that the repetition of Marian prayers which form the basis of the Rosary needed counting devices, which resulted in the modern form of the Rosary prayed on beads.

The practice of meditation during the praying of the Hail Marys was attributed to Dominic of Prussia (author of *Liber experientiarum* 1458), a 15th-century Carthusian monk, who called it the "Life of Jesus Rosary" (*vita Christi Rosarium*). However, in 1977, a theologian from Trier named Andreas Heinz discovered a *vita Christi Rosary* that dated to 1300, suggesting the origin of the current rosary extends back at least to that time. The Christian victory at the Battle of Lepanto in 1571 was attributed to the praying of the Rosary by masses of Europeans based on the request of Pope Pius V and eventually resulted in the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. In 1569, the papal bull *Consueverunt Romani Pontifices* established the devotion to the rosary in the Catholic Church. In 2002 Pope John Paul II introduced the Luminous Mysteries - based on a compilation by St George Preca the first Maltese Saint, - as an option in an Apostolic Letter on the Rosary, *Rosarium Virginis Mariae*.



Since we have been led to it, let's take a look at what prayer beads are and who uses them in the world. From Wikipedia:

**Prayer beads** are used by members of various religious traditions such as Hinduism, Buddhism, Christianity, Islam, Sikhism and the Bahá'í Faith to mark the repetitions of prayers, chants or devotions, such as the rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Catholicism, and dhikr (remembrance of God) in Islam.

The number of beads varies by religion or use. **Islamic prayer beads**, called Misbaha or Tasbeeh, usually have 100 beads (99 +1 = 100 beads in total or 33 beads read thrice and +1). **Buddhists and Hindus use the Japa Mala**, which usually has 108 beads, or 27 which are counted four times. **Baha'i prayer beads** consist of either 95 beads or 19 beads, which are strung with the addition of five beads below. **The Sikh Mala** also has 108 beads.

Roman Catholics use the Rosary (Latin "rosarium", meaning "rose garden") with 59 beads. However, Eastern Orthodox Christians use a knotted prayer rope called either a komboskini or chotki, with 100 knots, although prayer ropes with 50 or 33 knots can also be used. In Vita of Saint Paul of Thebes (227 A.D. to 342 A.D.), written by Saint Jerome (347 A.D. to 420 A.D.) it states that Saint Paul of Thebes used pebbles and knotted cord to count prayers. Although Anglo-Catholics have used the Dominican rosary since the 19th century, in the 1980s Rev. Lynn Bauman from the Episcopal Church in the United States of America introduced a Rosary for Anglicans with 33 beads.




So why is praying the rosary important? According to James Hough, Catechist in Catholic Parish Director for the RCIA (2000-present), this is why:

- The rosary is important because it is beginning Christian prayer: meditation on the various events in salvation history and asking God how to apply them in your life.
- It is important because Our Blessed Lady, herself, came from heaven and asked us to unite ourselves with her Son through this prayer each day.
- It is important because God is eternal, does not change, and came to us initially through this woman, and continues to do so.
- We become, spiritually, Christ's brothers, and she becomes our mother.
- The basis for a Christian life and salvation is humility, and this is where we start, asking for her intercession, and humbly asking her to intercede for us, the least of her children.

# How to Pray the Rosary



1. Make the Sign of the Cross and pray the Apostles' Creed.
2. Pray the Our Father.
3. Pray three Hail Marys.
4. Pray Glory Be to the Father.
5. Announce the mystery for reflection and pray the Our Father.
6. Pray the 10 Hail Marys.
7. Finish the decade with the Glory Be to the Father.

The repetition in the Rosary is meant to lead one into restful and contemplative prayer. So what does the Lord have to say about that?

**Matthew 6:7-8** - But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking. Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.

I think it is pretty clear that the Lord is telling us through scripture that we are to NOT follow the heathen in their prayer practices, and yet we have over a BILLION people doing the exact thing that the Lord is telling is NOT to do.

What do you think the outcome of this will be when people are being judged?

Look at the mental gymnastics that these people put themselves through, as they pray with decades, hail Marys and praying 'Our Fathers' and 'Glory be to the Father'. What these people fail to understand is that the Lord of Hosts is NOT listening to these 'prayers', as He is conversational and not pious. The Lord Jesus Christ wants to talk with you face to face, man to man (or woman), in clear words He called plainness of speech so you can understand Him, as you can see in scripture here:

**2 Corinthians 3:12** - Seeing then that we have such hope, we use great plainness of speech:

Now some Catholics will argue that praying the rosary is NOT the same as what scripture tells us, with the emphasis in vain.



Here is an excerpt from an article that explains that reasoning by a FR. Dwight Longenecker:

### **Why the Rosary is not “Vain Repetition”**

There is an aspect of Eastern meditation that is present in the use of the rosary however. The repetition of a mantra—a repetitious prayer does have an effect on our minds and hearts. What it does in Eastern meditation is that it occupies the “language channel” of the mind allowing the rest of the mind to enter a state of emptiness. This is the object of Eastern meditation. The repetitious prayer provides a kind of “background static” so that the mind can move beyond language to the realm of the Spirit.

This Eastern form of meditation is actually not only vain but spiritually dangerous. If a person is not baptized or protected by the Holy Spirit, once they have “emptied their mind” they can also open their mind and heart to foreign spirits. This is the criticism of Transcendental Meditation. The mantra the person is given to recite seems like a meaningless word. However, some critics say the word “Omm” is not a meaningless word, but the name of a Hindu deity and that an unprotected person, by chanting this name over and over is actually invoking a pagan god and inviting them into their heart and mind which has been conveniently vacated through the prayer technique.

The repetitious prayer of the rosary has a similar effect of occupying the linguistic channel of the mind, but instead of doing so with a meaningless word or phrase it depends on the deeply meaningful prayer of the Hail Mary which takes the person into the heart of the mystery of the incarnation.

The aim of the rosary therefore is not to empty the mind, but to fill the mind with the mysteries of the life of Christ. The aim of the rosary is not to enter a numb state of mental and emotional emptiness, but to enter into the fullness of the joyful, luminous, sorrowful and glorious mysteries and thereby to enter more fully and mysteriously into the life of Christ.

The rosary is one of those particularly Catholic traditions which does link us strangely to some non-Christian religions. Practitioners of Eastern religions and pagan religions do use repetitive prayer, and repetitive prayer clearly has some practical benefits: it occupies the linguistic channel of the mind thereby opening the super linguistic areas of the mind to a higher level of prayer. However, the rosary differs from those pagan forms of prayer because it does not take the religious disciple into a bland and blank state in which anything can happen. Instead it takes the disciple of Christ into a positive, powerful and meaningful participation in the mystery of the incarnation.

The rosary is therefore a powerful symbol of the whole of Catholic theology. Our religion is not an escape from reality or an avoidance of the physical. Instead it is an immersion in reality and a full participation in the physical. Our religion is not an escape from this world, but an embrace of this world. It is not a mental opt out, but a fully human opting in. Christian prayer is not an ethereal experience of another world, but a super charged experience of the other world penetrating this one through the mystery of the incarnation of the second person of the Trinity into this world through the amazing action of taking flesh of the Blessed Virgin.

The rosary is powerful and transformative because it is a daily, simply, prayerful and powerful participation in this mystery of our redemption and the redemption of the whole world.

My take on this article is that the author is splitting hairs trying to distance himself from the practices of the 'heathen'. How can you say in one sentence say 'yeah, there are some Eastern practices in reciting the rosary' and then say that this will help usher in the Holy Spirit?

Woe unto him that saith to the wood, Awake; to the dumb stone, Arise, it shall teach! Behold, it is laid over with gold and silver, and there is no breath at all in the midst of it.






So why are so many people intent on using the rosary?

It is because they have been indoctrinated into worshipping an object, no matter if it is a statue, some beads, a cross or a Pope. Get as far, far away from this as you can, as the rosary will send you to hell.

Why?

It is because people are using these beads with repetitive prayer as a means of worshipping the Lord, and he is not going to accept this at all.



Stop the madness, Christian. Get with the Lord Jesus Christ and talk with Him about how He wants you to approach Him and discard the pagan rituals that have been incorporated into the Catholic Church. This is NOT how the Lord wants us to worship Him; we need to worship in Spirit and in TRUTH.



As always, **take NOTHING that you have seen here in this book as the truth.** It is **YOUR responsibility to study and check out everything that you see and hear**, and you have an advocate in the Lord Jesus Christ who will help you if you would just ask Him.

It is **YOUR** responsibility to make sure **YOU** are in the faith and that **YOU** have completed **YOUR** sanctification during the sanctification process and **YOU** have gotten **YOUR** forgiveness and **YOU** have repented of all of **YOUR** sins before **YOU** are judged by Jesus.

Scripture tells us that hell will enlarge itself to accommodate all of the people who will be sent there because of idols like the pope, as you can see in scripture here:

**Isaiah 5:14** - Therefore hell hath enlarged herself, and opened her mouth without measure: and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp, and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it.

Take this as a warning, Christian, as the Lord Jesus Christ is NOT desperate for people, as **there were only 8 people** who got on the ark before the flood, and **only 2 people** from the Hebrews from Egypt made it into the Promised Land.

Be wise, and stay IN Jesus so you are not lost.



## Here is Our Challenge to all of you:

We challenge you to go to Jesus directly **RIGHT NOW** and ask Him if what is shown here is true. Use this as a means to start a conversation with The Lord Jesus Christ and sit with Him and ask Him questions. Start with **(asking out loud):**

**“Jesus, is what I just read true?”**

He will answer you, Christian; use this as an opportunity to start the conversation with the Lord Jesus Christ. Keep talking with Him. Get to know Him and He will start to reveal Himself to you.

You need to find out for yourself if what you support or believe is true, and what better way to find out than to ask the Lord Himself? You need to find out for yourself and work out **YOUR** salvation for **YOU**, as the scriptures tell us to.



## Get into the FIGHT

After you have gotten right with the Lord and secured your household, you can continue your service to the Lord by getting into the fight. You already have experience casting out devils, and standing up to Jezebel; you are fiercely defending your household against all threats and you have overcome them. Your household is in order; your family is in order; there is peace in your household, and all defiling elements have been dealt with for now.

So what do you do?

Stay in the fight!!

You have already made a reputation for yourself and the demons will leave you alone because you have stood up to them! I'll give you an example of a household that has fought this fight.

The Granger household consists of a husband and a wife with no children (yet). The husband has battled with Jezebel, who manifested in his wife, and after a few battles, Jezebel is leaving the husband and the wife alone. Although Jezebel grumbles that the husband is too smug for her tastes, and she wants to cut off his balls and stuff them down his throat, she is all talk because she has no stomach to fight this man anymore for his household.



THAT is where you want to be, Christian.

The husband has had to teach his wife about casting out demons and how to defend herself against attacks by using her Recompensatory prayers, which she has used to beat off the offenders. The wife, now emboldened because she has seen her husband deal with the demons that plagued her, was afraid at first; now, she is, in her own words, “folding the demons like a cheap suit and stuffing them into a trash can”. The wife overcame ALL fear of the demons that have plagued her since she was a child and now she is exerting HER authority as a member of a household that is in order and a marriage that is in order.

You see, when there is order, there is POWER, and the devil and his cohorts only recognize power. Do they have more power than you? You have an advocate in Jesus, as He will grant you the power and authority you need to continue the fight. Do what he tells you to do, and He will grant you the power you need plus more, if He feels you are worthy of it.

You do not have to be a preacher, or an apostle, or a bishop to continue the fight against the devil. You can take on roles that are important that you can comfortably do. As always, **take this to the Lord and ask Him directly** what you can do for Him.



## Become a martyr

Another type of person who plays a role in the fight is one of a martyr. So what is a martyr?

A **martyr** is defined as:

1. a person who willingly suffers death rather than renounce his or her religion.
2. a person who is put to death or endures great suffering on behalf of any belief, principle, or cause:
3. a person who undergoes severe or constant suffering:

In the Bible, a martyr is defined as a witness.

You may say that a martyr is one that will give up his/her life for others willingly even if they get killed in the process. I would say that a martyr is akin to the Marines, as they storm the beaches and assault the enemy. The martyr corps will be the ones that will go back into the cities to rescue trapped saints of God when the devil cuts off all means of being able to escape when things collapse.

The martyrs are the ones that will assault the devil face to face, using weapons they have been specially trained to use. The martyrs know the score when they volunteer, and they are aware that every mission that they are sent on may be their last mission. They know that they can get killed at any time, and are willing to go where others are afraid to tread.

In the bible, most martyrs are killed by the enemy, but not before the martyrs inflict heavy damage to the devil's forces. The first martyr we read about is Stephen, and an account of his martyrdom is found in **Acts Chapters 6 and 7**. You can read about him in your own study time.

Notice how Jesus not only let Stephen get killed, as he was after Saul, who recorded this in **Acts 22:20**, but Stephen was a man who had great power and was full of the Holy Ghost (**Acts 6:8**). What did Stephen do that caused him to be brought up on charges that cost him his life? He proclaimed the gospel, healed the sick and cast out devils as Jesus has asked all of his disciples to do.

This is what I meant by being on the front lines. Stephen was unafraid to go and do the work that Jesus had for his disciples who was to confront the devil and use extreme prejudice to get those who the Lord wants out from the enslavement of the devil with POWER. He went into the belly of the beast unafraid and alone, and look what it took to bring him down.

I personally like Stephen and what he did. Stephen is the prototype of what a martyr will and can do. If Stephen alone did such a good job that the devil had to kill him, what do you think a whole corps of martyrs will do?

The devil so despised Stephen, he had him arrested on trumped up charges. During the trial, Stephen was so full of the Holy Ghost, that he actually glowed (**Acts 6:15**). I don't know about you, but THAT is the way I want to go when my time is up. Never mind the cowering bit; I want to step up to the devil boldly, stomp his guts out, shake the dust off my feet and then stomp his guts out again, just for good measure.

If you were ever in the military, and you have gone through the training, you would be a good fit for this job (even if you did not serve in the military, the Lord could use you if you ask Him). Not only will you get to fight the enemy face to face, hand to hand, up close and personal, you have a commander in Chief that is The Lord of Lords and King of Kings, and he does NOT forget the things that His Martyr corps does, unlike the armed services in America or wherever you are from. The martyr corps is the best of the best and full of the Holy Ghost. **The devil most fears the martyr corps because of the power they have in Christ.**

How do I know that the devil fears the martyr corps?

It is because the devil does not hesitate to kill them. You can see all throughout the book of Acts and Revelation that the martyrs are the ones that are killed.

Why?

The devil cannot stand up to the power that they have, so to save himself and his piddly little kingdom, the devil has them killed. The martyrs walk in and destroy the devil's kingdom, nuking everything and laying it to waste. The devil cannot stop them using his usual trickery, so he has them killed, usually by confederates who are religious.

In Revelations, you can see that the Harlot drinks the blood of the saints and the martyrs (**Revelation 17:6**). Why did the Lord make a distinction between the saints and the martyrs? It looks to me like the martyrs were more of a threat, as they normally destroy everything in sight that is demonic. Notice it is the Harlot, or the religious church, that is killing these people. We saw that in Stephen's time, and we will see it again during the end times.

Not everyone is cut out to be a martyr, but you can always **ask Jesus to put you in His martyr corps** or wherever He feels you would fit the best. If you like impossible missions against impossible odds, this is the place for you. As I said before, to all of the people who were in the military that were sent to hellholes like Afghanistan and Iraq, this is the place for you.

Get on your knees and ask and beg the Lord Jesus to clean you up for service. Ask him to train you in all of the weapons that are available to the martyr corps so you will be productive. Ask Jesus to clean you up so you are off of all of the 'chems' that the armed services give their members who are not useful to them anymore until they are discharged. If you do this, your PTSD will subside; you will also be able to get the blood of those you killed in the name of the military off of your hands so you will have peace.

You can then get your payback against the devil who was using you to bring over his hordes of demons to this realm using the death or sacrifice(s) of those you killed for the military, who care nothing about you. Look at the VA and then tell me I am wrong. The people you were fighting for has the military protect their pipelines and poppy fields so they can enslave more people with their drugs, and then they give you a medal for your service, even if you got hurt or injured during your service. This is a DIRTY deal that many have taken because that is the only deal they can get.

If you are going to fight, fight for a TRUE cause and kingdom. Ask Jesus to allow you into His corps.


