



From the admin about: Women Pastors

We received an e-mail from Stacy L. on 9/1/2017, which stated the following:

Not sure I agree with your idea about women pastors. Was just speaking with someone today about how it seems that a lot of men are spiritually asleep and how it seems like now a days women are the spiritual warriors in their households and the churches.

Our response: First of all, thank you, Stacy, for your e-mail. Although it looks like we are bashing females, we are not. What we are showing is that women pastors are out of order. Either these women are ignorant of God's divine order or just don't care about it at all.

We will agree that the men are asleep spiritually, or else there would more of a response to things that are out of order. What we will point out is that men and women have God ordained roles that they are to operate within. Women are not ordained to be spiritual warriors by themselves, nor are they to take on the role of a man, just as a man is not to take on the role of a woman. Understand that a woman's role may be subordinate to the man's (you can thank Eve for that), but is equally important, if not more important, than a man's role. Without a woman as the helper, the man will not be able to fulfill his role.

Why?

It is because the Lord of Hosts has designed His ordained order to be this way.

The mistake that women are making today is that they are trying to 'take over' and fulfill the man's role. What should be done is the woman should **remain in her role as the helper**, and **reach out to Jesus to have Him step into the role of the man** as a placeholder so the household will be preserved and protected.

Make no mistake - households are being attacked right now, and by diminishing the role of the man, the household will be out of order. An out of order household is a household that is easily conquered by the devil and the inhabitants enslaved.

The woman, if she sees her man not fulfilling his role, **is to go to The Lord Jesus Christ directly and ask HIM to step into the male role.** This way, not only is the woman safe in her role/household, she is not overstepping her role, and the household is in order and protected against any outside/external attacks. This is the 'correct' way to preserve the household if the man abdicates or is unable to fulfill his role. It will then be up to Jesus to awaken the man while the wife intercedes for her husband so he can be restored in his role and the household is righted and in Order.

If you ask Jesus directly if He would step in and help, you will see that He would. Many of you are trying to do everything by yourselves under your own power and authority (which is no power/authority if you try and go against the devil) when we have the Lord Jesus Christ whom we can ask for help who has more power and authority than the devil. **Jesus will help us IF we would just ask Him!!** Conversely, if the woman abdicates

her role, the husband can ask the Holy Spirit to step into her role as helpmeet and keep the household righted and in order.

It is imperative that you stay IN Order at all times to preserve your households, and you CAN ask for help. Know that the Lord will NOT recognize or do anything to help households that are out of Order. As always, you should **take this issue to the Lord Jesus Christ and verify it with Him**.
