



Israel: Israelites and Jews are NOT ‘God’s Chosen’

In this article, we show Biblically that the Jews and the people in Israel that are NOT born again and the Jews are NOT ‘God’s Chosen’. In fact, the Born Again person who follows Jesus or the Disciples of Christ Are the ‘chosen of God’, a peculiar people and a royal priesthood.

They say they are the 'chosen people of god' - again, referencing the Old Testament, **but they became 'un-chosen' by the Lord of Hosts because of their disobedience to Him**, even when He told them the penalty of disobedience.

They say that since they are 'god's chosen', they are reconstituting the Jews into the land they picked so they could have a Jewish 'spiritual center', which is NOT of the Lord of Hosts as **He took away their inheritance because of disobedience**. What you see here are people trying to override the Lord of Hosts.

They say that anyone who does not support them will be cursed by God, as they claim to be Abraham's seed and anyone who blesses them will be blessed by God, and they quote Genesis 12:3 as their proof text, **as we have shown is erroneous as Israel was added to this conversation for some reason**. The main reason for this error are the **notes in the Scofield Bible**, which people are reading into and are getting bad doctrine because of those notes.

Can't see a theme here, Christian?

- Did you catch that **disobedience** is what did these people in with the Lord of Hosts?
- Can't you see that **these people are 'stiff-necked'**, as the Lord of Hosts called them, to this day?
- Can you see what **'they say'** is always glossing over what **'they did' to piss the Lord of Hosts off?**

We believe that It is this invocation of God and what He did in the Old Testament by Israel, who HATE His Son Jesus, is the crux of the problem, and the Lord of Hosts is NOT having any of that. **These people are liars**, as they did not tell you the rest of the story! **They are using the Name of the Lord of Hosts for their own gain**. Consider these points:

- The land that was given to the Hebrews and the Children of Israel, the 'Promised land', was **promised with the condition that they OBEY the statutes and laws of the Lord of Hosts**, as shown in **Leviticus** and **Deuteronomy**. The Lord of Hosts was **VERY specific about what would happen if they disobeyed**, as you can see in scripture here:

Leviticus 26:27-39 - **And if ye will not for all this hearken unto me, but walk contrary unto me; Then I will walk contrary unto you also in fury; and I, even I, will chastise you seven times for your sins. And ye shall eat the flesh of your sons, and the flesh of your daughters shall ye eat. And I will destroy your high places, and cut down your images, and cast your carcasses upon the carcasses of your idols, and my soul shall abhor you.**

And I will make your cities waste, and bring your sanctuaries unto desolation, and I will not smell the savour of your sweet odours. And I will bring the land into desolation: and your enemies which dwell therein shall be astonished at it. And I will scatter you among the heathen, and will draw out a sword after you: and your land shall be desolate, and your cities waste. Then shall the land enjoy her sabbaths, as long as it lieth desolate, and ye be in your enemies' land; even then shall the land rest, and enjoy her sabbaths. As long as it lieth desolate it shall rest; because it did not rest in your sabbaths, when ye dwelt upon it.

And upon them that are left alive of you I will send a faintness into their hearts in the lands of their enemies; and the sound of a shaken leaf shall chase them; and they shall flee, as fleeing from a sword; and they shall fall when none pursueth. And they shall fall one upon another, as it were before a sword, when none pursueth: and ye shall have no power to stand before your enemies. And ye shall perish among the heathen, and the land of your enemies shall eat you up. And they that are left of you shall pine away in their iniquity in your enemies' lands; and also in the iniquities of their fathers shall they pine away with them.

- When the Lord of Hosts got fed up with the disobedience of the Hebrews from Egypt, The Lord marched them around in the wilderness for 40 years until they **died off except for two people – Joshua and Caleb. Out of the millions of the original Hebrews, only 2 made it into the Promised Land.** You can see in scripture here why this was the case;

Numbers 26:65 - For the LORD had said of them, They shall surely die in the wilderness. And there was not left a man of them, save Caleb the son of Jephunneh, and Joshua the son of Nun.

- When the Lord of Host got fed up with the disobedience of the Children of Israel, He sent them into bondage not once, but twice, and after the 2nd time, He divorced Himself of the Children of Israel, and **took away their inheritance and left them desolate.** You can see this in scripture here:\

Leviticus 26:33 - And I will scatter you among the heathen, and will draw out a sword after you: and your land shall be desolate, and your cities waste.

- When the Lord of Hosts sent His Son Jesus to bring the Jews back into the fold, **the Jews killed Jesus** by butchering Him on a tree, not knowing that the Lord Jesus Christ has put curses upon them **because of their disobedience and not accepting Jesus as their Messiah.**

In addition to this, the **inheritance of the Children of Israel was taken away from them** and has been given to the New Israel, the people who walk by the Spirit of God as Disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ, also known as **those who are Born Again**, as shown here;

Galatians 3:14 - That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

This scripture right here proves that **there is NO Blessing on or for the Children of Israel**, and that the people who use **Genesis 12:3** to say that the current day Jews in Israel are being blessed because they are Abraham's seed are in ERROR. Let's take a quick look at this:

Genesis 12:1-4 - Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: **And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.** So Abram departed, as the LORD had spoken unto him; and Lot went with him: and Abram was seventy and five years old when he departed out of Haran.

OK, so what does this say?

Basically, what it said is that the Lord of Hosts was going to make Abraham a great nation, and Abraham's name will be great. The Lord told Abraham that He is going to bless him (Abraham) and those who bless Abraham will be blessed by the Lord, and those who curse Abraham will be cursed.

Where does it say ANYTHING about Israel?

In the context of this scripture, which is why we have posted verses 1-4, the Lord told Abraham to go to a place that He would send Abraham, and He was going to watch out for and take care of Abraham and his family. THAT'S ALL this passage says.

So how did it get twisted to include all of Israel?

Here is another scripture that solidifies our point that there is NO inheritance for the Children of Israel:

Galatians 3:16 - Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ.

The curses put on the Jews who killed Christ have NOT been taken off of them, and **these people are cursed to this very day**, although they tell you that they are the 'chosen ones'. Check out the curses that are on the Jews that hate Christ **here**.

So in about a page or so, we have shown the proof scripturally that the Jews in Israel are NOT God's chosen because **the Lord of Hosts stripped them of their inheritance**. However, they are god's chosen, and that is the god of this earth – satan himself.

So who are the 'chosen people' of God?

The 'chosen people' of God **are those who are Born Again and are followers and Disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ**.

Yes, them.

How do we know?

Let's see what scripture says:

Romans 1:1 - Paul, a servant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated unto the gospel of God,

If you recall in your bible studies, there were only 12 apostles that Jesus chose, or called. Judas Iscariot was called and chosen, but he fell away when he betrayed Jesus. Matthias was chosen by the disciples, but nothing ever came from him because Jesus did not personally call or choose him. It was Saul, who persecuted the Christian, who became Paul, and you can see the dramatic situation where Saul was made into Paul in scripture here:

Acts 9:3-6 - And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven: And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: *it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks*. And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do.

As you can clearly see in this account, when you are chosen by Jesus, it is a dramatic experience that you DO NOT FORGET. In contrast to the Jews who say they are God's chosen, you can clearly see that they are NOT because they have not experienced the dramatic and life changing event when God DOES choose them.

Every person who has born again for REAL (not that mamby pamby stuff you see in most churches) will tell you that their experience was dramatic when Jesus chose them. Their lives changed for REAL and for GOOD and it is not something you need to think about or hem and haw about.

Let's read on for more proof that the Born Again Christian is 'God's Chosen':

Romans 1:5-7 - Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; And declared *to be* the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead: By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the faith among all nations, for his name: **Among whom are ye also the called of Jesus Christ:** To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called *to be* saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

You can see that no one comes to Jesus without being called, as you can plainly see here:

1 Corinthians 1:1-2 - Paul, *called to be* an apostle of Jesus Christ through the will of God, and Sosthenes *our* brother, Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, **to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints**, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus **Christ** our Lord, both theirs and ours:

1 Corinthians 1:9 - So that ye come behind in no gift; waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall also confirm you unto the end, *that ye may be* blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. **God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.**

1 Corinthians 1:20-24 – *Where is* the wise? *where is* the scribe? *where is* the disputer of this world? hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe. For the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after wisdom: But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; **But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks**, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God. Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

Are you starting to get the picture?

Galatians 1:1-8 - Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father, who raised him from the dead;) And all the brethren which are with me, unto the churches of Galatia: Grace *be* to you and peace from God the Father, and *from* our Lord Jesus Christ, Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father: To whom *be* glory for ever and ever. Amen. I marvel that **ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel:** Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ. But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

2 Thessalonians 2:13-14 - But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth: **Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.** Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle.

1 Peter 5:10 - But the God of all grace, **who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus,** after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you.

Jude 1:1 - Jude, the servant of Jesus **Christ,** and brother of James, to them that are **sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called:**

Now, many of you are saying that being called is NOT the same as being chosen, and you are right. We have to be called and THEN you are chosen, as you see here in scripture:

Revelation 17:14 - These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they **that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful.**

And what about this:

1 Peter 2:9-10 - But ye **are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people;** that ye should shew forth the praises of **him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:** Which in time past *were* not a people, but **are now the people of God:** which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.

That just about sums it up, doesn't it?

So those who are Born Again are both called and chosen, and you can see that the Lord has made this generation – the people who follow the Lord Jesus Christ – a 'chosen' generation. The people **who are Born Again for REAL are now the people of God,** NOT the Jews.

So what happened to the children of Israel, you may ask. They were chosen of God too, isn't that true?

The short answer is yes, as long as you are obedient, you are 'chosen'. The Children of Israel decided to NOT be obedient, and they lost everything – their inheritance, the land, their 'chosen' status – everything - and **were replaced with those who are Born Again in the Lord Jesus Christ as the 'chosen' people.**



Here is Our Challenge to all of you:

We challenge you to go to Jesus directly **RIGHT NOW** and ask Him if what is shown here is true. Use this as a means to start a conversation with The Lord Jesus Christ and sit with Him and ask Him questions. Start with **(asking out loud):**

“Jesus, is what I just read true?”

He will answer you and NOW you will be on the true road to salvation, knowing for **SURE** if you are going to make it or not, as Jesus would have told you. Keep talking with Him. Get to know Him and He will start to reveal Himself to you. You need to find out for yourself and work out **YOUR** salvation for **YOU**, as the scriptures tell us to.

In closing, we want to give you an EXACT QUOTE we got from Jesus Himself:

"Disciples of mine will make it into my Kingdom; Christians will NOT."

Take heed and **don't just blow this off**. What is being presented here is IMPORTANT!! Read and understand what the Lord Jesus Christ is saying to all of us. As we always say, **do not take anything we say as the gospel; ALWAYS confirm what you are reading or hearing by running it by the Lord Jesus Christ yourself**. Keep talking to Jesus and He will respond to you. Have Him explain WHY what is being said is true. Talk with the Lord Jesus Christ and get to know Him personally.
