

Kingdom Law Legal Vocabulary:

Judgment, Judgments

A judicial judgment is defined as:

1. a judicial decision given by a judge or court.
2. the obligation arising from a judicial decision.
3. the certificate embodying such a decision and issued against the obligor, especially a debtor.

This is how the Lord of Hosts handles judgments:

A judgment is when the Lord of Hosts weighs the evidence of a person or being that has violated or fulfilled kingdom laws. Usually this is to adjudicate any behaviours or actions of people as well as being. If a being or a person violates kingdom law, they will be judged. The penalty or reward of that judgment is **immediate** and **not reversible**.

Take note of the highlighted terms, Christian.

Now you can see why judgment is such a serious thing. You know that if you are judged and found lacking, you will go into the Lake of Fire. Many people will be shocked at their judgment, as they will be found lacking. This is why you must pick up your cross and bear it DAILY, as Jesus told us to do. Once the judgment is made, it is **NOT REVERSABLE**.



Here is Our Challenge to all of you:

We challenge you to go to Jesus directly **RIGHT NOW** and ask Him if what is shown here is true. Use this as a means to start a conversation with The Lord Jesus Christ and sit with Him and ask Him questions. Start with **(asking out loud):**

“Jesus, is what I just read true?”

He will answer you, Christian; use this as an opportunity to start the conversation with the Lord Jesus Christ. Keep talking with Him. Get to know Him and He will start to reveal Himself to you.

You need to find out for yourself if what you support or believe is true, and what better way to find out than to ask the Lord Himself? You need to find out for yourself and work out **YOUR** salvation for **YOU**, as the scriptures tell us to.
