



Advice for those who have just  
been Born Again:  
Proclaim the Gospel and do  
**NOT** sell the Gospel

This short book is for those who are new to the Gospel and who are wrestling with going out to preach the Gospel. There are a few things that you should keep in mind as you do this for the Kingdom of God.

**You need to be quiet, sit down, and learn of Jesus Christ first.** If the Lord Jesus Christ wants you to go and do something for Him, He will not only tell you what He wants you to do, but **He will prepare you for the journey and the task He is sending you to do.** Stay with Jesus and follow Him; do NOT run ahead of Jesus.

Many people tell you that you need to go and spread the gospel. **Not now.** You will have plenty of time to do that once you are fully trained and sent by the Lord Jesus Christ. Some will point out that we are commanded to proclaim the gospel, and we are, **but NOT UNTIL YOU ARE FULLY PREPARED TO.** It makes no sense for a new Christian to go out and try to proclaim something they know little about or the enemy that will cave in their skull that they know nothing about.

You will find that when the Lord Jesus Christ authorizes you to go or do something for Him, you will be prepared fully before you go. **Many of the people you see out on the internet and on YouTube are NOT AUTHORIZED to be out there proclaiming anything.**

This is advice from those of us who are out here in the trenches, Christian. Heed these words and WAIT for Jesus to tell you what He wants to do. Don't run out ahead of Jesus and try to forge your way in the world. Let Jesus guide you and tell you exactly what He wants you to do before you do anything.

Remain obedient to the Lord Jesus Christ and go ONLY when He sends you.



Now, when the Lord Jesus Christ DOES give you the training and preparation that you need, then when you go, keep these things in mind:

You are to proclaim the gospel, and NOT sell it. You are not on commission, and you do NOT have to sell anything. As you can see, those who went out from Jesus proclaimed the Gospel, and then those who were interested in what they

had to say were ministered to. All you do is answer questions and point them to Jesus.

Christian, on your own, you cannot save anyone; however, recognize that you are a vessel that Jesus is using to proclaim the gospel. Be that vessel; if people turn away, then it **is NOT YOUR JOB to try to get them back. LET THEM GO.** Everyone has free will, and people can accept or reject the gospel as they choose.

**Once you are ministering to someone, then you will need to heed the leading of the Holy Ghost and do exactly what He tells you to do.** He may have you go up to a person who is having a rough day with a good word for them; He may tell you to leave a person alone, as that person is reprobate and God doesn't want them at all, even though they seem reasonable to you. **You will need to listen to the Holy Ghost and do exactly what He tells you to do.**



You will need to learn to go when the Holy Ghost tells you to go, and that is only obtained by you spending time with Jesus and waiting for Him to send you on your way.





Many people, in their zeal for Christ, will go out and do things that they are not ready for. However, if the Holy Ghost gives you permission to approach someone to proclaim the Gospel, by all means – GO! **Learn how to walk WITH the Holy Ghost and do NOTHING on your own volition.**

Now, this is going to fly in the face of what many pastors tell you, as they are using YOU to bring more people into their church when they send you unprepared. This is their means of building up their congregation to get even more money with a salesforce that they do not have to pay for. In effect, the pastor is trying to pimp God to enrich himself.

I would NOT want to be that pastor on judgment day.

So what kind of proclaiming will you do?

It will depend on you and what the Holy Ghost has for you to do. Sometimes that may mean

street preaching; it may mean knocking on doors. It will be some means that YOU will be able to do, as this is between YOU and the Holy Ghost.

Many people tell you that you need to proclaim this way or that way, and if you do not do well enough, then you failed.

No.

There is NO Failure with the Lord Jesus Christ. He knows what you are doing and when you do it. Talk with the Lord Jesus Christ and see what He wants you to do and then do that.

You may be asked to talk in front of a group; you may be in a mall that the Lord sent you to proclaim the gospel; you may be at an amusement park or at a pool somewhere where you can talk about Jesus as He wants you to proclaim. We should ALWAYS ask Jesus what HE wants us to do and then we will do it.

Sometimes, you may be minding your business and the Holy Ghost will tell you 'go and talk to that person and give them the Gospel'. You may be afraid initially, but you GO when the Holy Ghost tells you to go. You may be the only Born Again person around for miles and Jesus is counting on you to proclaim the Gospel for Him. When this is done, the Holy Ghost and/or Jesus Christ will prepare you for your task and it is up to YOU to fulfill the commands that Jesus gives you.

Finally, know that Jesus will NOT send you if He didn't have confidence in you to do the job that He asked you to do, so put aside the fear and step out in faith to do what Jesus tells you to do. At some point in time, you will be sent out to proclaim the gospel, and that proclamation will get you killed. We can see this with Stephen in the book of Acts, as he was proclaiming the Gospel and that got him arrested and thrown in jail. Peter and Paul were always in jail somewhere because they would NOT shut up, and they told the ruling parties that to their faces.

When you are sent to proclaim the Gospel, **you become VERY BOLD when you are sent by the Lord Jesus Christ.** You will be

saying things that you would not expect to say. You would be bold in your proclamation of Christ and you do not care who hears it. All of this happens when you are prepared and then sent by Jesus Christ or the Holy Ghost.

It is suggested **that you sit down with Jesus and the Holy Ghost and be honest with them about proclaiming the Gospel.** Let them know you are afraid; be HONEST with them, even if you do not want to do the task. **The Lord Jesus Christ and the Holy Ghost will respond to you and they will prepare you** because you are a vessel that they can use.

What will happen is that you will build up your confidence IN Christ, and then you will be able to go without worrying about anything. In the coming days, there will be a LOT of people who will need ministering to, especially if there is a disaster or an earthquake or flood. People get desperate, and this is the best time to go out and proclaim the Gospel, especially if you can help people at the same time.

No matter what, **discuss this with Jesus and work out something with Him.** He will help you get to the point where you can be able to serve Him.



## Here is Our Challenge to all of you:

We challenge you to go to Jesus directly **RIGHT NOW** and ask Him if what is shown here is true. Use this as a means to start a conversation with The Lord Jesus Christ and sit with Him and ask Him questions. Start with **(asking out loud):**

**“Jesus, is what I just read true?”**

He will answer you, Christian; use this as an opportunity to start the conversation with the Lord Jesus Christ. Keep talking with Him. Get to know Him and He will start to reveal Himself to you.

You need to find out for yourself if what you support or believe is true, and what better way to find out than to ask the Lord Himself? You need to find out for yourself and work out **YOUR** salvation for **YOU**, as the scriptures tell us to.
