Nobody is forcing you to believe anything, Christian, so settle down.

It will be **YOUR** salvation on the line, so use this time you have to make your election **SURE** and work out YOUR salvation with fear and trembling by **confirming it with the Lord Jesus Christ directly YOURSELF, since Jesus is going to be judging you** when you die anyway.



So, you think you are saved, eh?

Many think that because they made a 'confession' at an altar in a church, they are saved.

No.

That is not true.

Much of what we have been taught over the years about Jesus and salvation is NOT true. Many people are going around **right now thinking that they are 'saved' when they are NOT.**

Salvation is a process, and as with anything, you have to go through the process to get a desired result. So, let's explain the process so you will be able to understand.

When you come to Jesus, you are worldly, nasty, filthy, and disgusting. It is like you lived in a pigpen, and you decided to go to the King and say, OK, Jesus, I will be yours. Jesus has to clean you up, and then make you suitable to be in His presence. The process of getting you out of the filth of the world and cleaning you up for Jesus' pleasure is what salvation really is.

Even the word **salvation**, when we look it up in the dictionary, means:

noun

1. **the act of saving or protecting** from harm, risk, loss, destruction, etc.
2. **the state of being saved or protected** from harm, risk, etc.
3. a source, cause, or **means of being saved or protected** from harm, risk, etc.
4. Theology. deliverance from the power and penalty of sin; **redemption.**

So, let's agree that **salvation** is:

the **act** of saving, or protecting from harm, risk, loss, destruction, etc.;
the **state** of being saved or protected from harm, risk, etc.;
the **means** of being saved or protected from harm, risk, etc.
deliverance from the power and penalty of sin;
and **redemption.**

This is a loaded definition, isn't it? This is why salvation is nothing to play with. This is serious business and this should be on the mind of every person who is not saved. So, let's take closer look at what is involved If you salvage something.

You would expect to:

- Get the item you want from the surroundings it was in, which may or may not be the normal or natural surroundings
- Preserve the item you want once it is removed from where you found it
- Clean the item up so it will be useful to you
- Put the item in the place where you intended it to be put
- Enjoy the fruit of the item as the item is used where you want it to be used
- You hold onto and take care of the item because it is precious to you

Isn't that exactly what the Lord does with us?

Then what about those who think that a person is 'saved' forever by a confession ONLY?

Do you really think that the Lord Jesus Christ is going to allow us into the Kingdom of God, His home, all stank and nasty, dirty, filthy and putrid, looking pathetic, with skid marks and boo-boo stains with the accompanying smells, looking like we just rolled out of bed without showering or taking a bath for 20 years, with dragon breath that would kill a bird in mid-flight and cause paint to peel off walls all by itself because we have never brushed our teeth - ever?

C'mon, Man.

Be serious.

You have to **go through the process of being cleaned up so you CAN be put on the path of salvation and sanctification**. That is the NARROW PATH the Holy Ghost puts us on that few find to the Narrow Gate.

You are NOT saved YET.

Think of it this way - if you walk into a board meeting at your job looking raggedy and smelling like last year's underwear, do you really think that you are appropriate to be in that meeting making important decisions? You could be the CEO who was lost at sea and just found, but what makes you think you can just jump into the CEO's chair without being cleaned up, briefed, and then brought up to speed on what the company is doing and the direction that it is going?

Salvation is a lot like that, as Jesus Himself tells us that we will be judging angels. How are we going to judge angels when we are filthy, unholy, stank and nasty from sin? Jesus has to clean us up first.



Another analogy

Let's say that you live in a city, and a rich benefactor gives you a Gulfstream V free of charge. You barely have a driver's license, so what are you going to do with a Gulfstream V? After all, it's a free gift, right? Do you REALLY think you are going to jump into the left seat of that cockpit, with NO training or preparation, when you don't know an altimeter from a turn-and-slip indicator, and be able to fly that plane?

Of course you wouldn't.

What is going to happen is you will **go through the process** of learning about airplanes, how to fly, the learning about all of the systems on your new Gulfstream V, and then learning how to care for and maintain your new Gulfstream V. You have to **go through the process** of learning how to be a responsible Gulfstream V owner/operator.

This is why the Eternal Security doctrine is **error**.

The Lord Jesus Christ puts every one of us on a path on which we are taught, cleaned up, and where we obey our Lord as He makes us more like Him each day while we are on that path so we are suitable for Heaven when we die.

If you haven't noticed, the Lord Jesus Christ, His Father, the Lord of Hosts, and the Holy Spirit **ALWAYS prepare people** for any works or things that they want done. Throughout the Bible, you can see the Lord of Hosts prepare people to do the things that He wanted done. You can see how **The Lord Jesus Christ prepared Saul**, who later became Paul, for the work that he was to do spreading the gospel. You can see this with the 11 disciples and Judas Iscariot, and **for 3.5 years Jesus taught them and prepared them for the work they had to do** (except for Judas, as he was stealing from the purse throughout the 3.5 years he was with Jesus. Notice, though, that Judas was able to cast out devils with the rest, as Jesus gave him the same authority as the others).

So what makes you think that a measly 'confession' would be enough to prepare you for eternity?

What makes YOU think that Jesus is going to let you into His home, knowing that you are unprepared?

Jesus is the gatekeeper of Heaven, and if you did not know this, **He is NOT going to let any sin into His home.** You have to be prepared to enter in to your rest, and you have to be prepared so you can reside in the Kingdom of God. Remember the scripture where Jesus says that His Father's house has many mansions and that He will **PREPARE** one for you? If A Mansion is being prepared for you by Jesus, do you not think you would need to be prepared for it by Jesus?



If you were able to get to the Kingdom of God by 'believing' only, you would perish

The scriptures say that No man has ever seen The Lord of Hosts face, correct?

Why is that?

it is because we would not be able to survive looking at the Lord of Hosts, so He hides himself from us for OUR own good.

So, as an example, **let's just say that the once saved always saved doctrine is correct.** You confess, say a sinner's prayer, and then do nothing to else. You then die and because of your belief, you get to the Kingdom of God. **Do you really think that you could even survive that without being prepared? If you cannot even look the Lord of Hosts in the face without you perishing, as the scriptures tell us, how are you going to make your abode with the Lord for Eternity?**

Can you now see why the once saved, always saved doctrine is **error**?

On doing the research on this Eternal Security issue, we have noticed that many people who ascribe to this doctrine ALWAYS say that they are 'just a sinner'.

You did know that **Jesus is not going to let any SIN into the Kingdom of God**, correct?

With your own mouth, you have **just disqualified yourself from entering into the Kingdom of God** by calling yourself a 'sinner'. We should stop right there, but we are going to keep showing you that this doctrine is error as much as we can.

If you are a saint, you do NOT willfully sin, because your nature will stop you from wanting to. As a saint, you will repent of all of your sins, and when you do sin as you are being cleaned up, you will repent of the sin(s) you did. **You are NOT a sinner** in this regard because **you are under the governance of Jesus Christ**.

Know that if you keep saying that you are a sinner, once saved, always saved person, you negate your confession at the altar and you will NOT make it, as you will have sin on you because you spoke it on yourself. Remember, the bible does tell us by your words you will be saved, and by your words you will be damned. Some food for thought for you, Eternal Security guy/lady, free of charge.

It is not our intent to beat a dead horse about once saved, always saved because that is a fruitless debate, but it is our intent to show you how silly and demonic it is. **We say - believe what you want to believe**. If you believe once saved, always saved is right for you, then go with that. However, this website has pointed out that this doctrine is error, and you can accept our conclusion (running it by Jesus first, of course) or you can reject our conclusion and believe what you want.

The bottom line here is that **we really do not care what you believe, as this is YOUR salvation you are gambling with. We are providing information for you to use to make a choice.**

This website also points out that you can walk away from your salvation, and Jesus is going to let you do that if you want to. You have a free will, and Jesus is NOT going to infringe upon that.



So how does a person walk away from their salvation?

You can walk away from your salvation by NOT listening to or obeying the person who is the gatekeeper of Heaven!! Jesus is the gatekeeper, **and He is telling all of us what we need to do to get in.** He wants us to **REPENT**, and clear all of the sin from our ledger, and He wants us to be more like Him, walking in His holiness as He is Holy. He wants us ALL to get in and be with Him for eternity, but people, being people, choose not to take up Jesus' offer.

- Some don't want to go through the process that prepares them for Heaven, **so they are excluded.**
- Others decide that they do not have time for Jesus right now, **so they are excluded.**
- Others are too busy making money so they can have all of the fine babes and the big house, **so they are excluded.**
- Others are more concerned about 'their sexy' than about Jesus and what He has for them, **so they are excluded.**
- Others start out with Jesus, but walk away from Jesus when the devil sends his agents. **For now, they are excluded.**

- Others are religious, and like being religious, so they ignore Jesus. **They are excluded.**
- Others are doing a bunch of stuff to work their way to Heaven, bypassing Jesus. **They are excluded.**
- Others love their sexual perversions, and they HATE Jesus for bringing it up. **They are excluded.**
- Others think Jesus is some sort of clown or a 'sugar daddy' that will give them stuff. **They are excluded.**
- Others are pimping Jesus' name so they can get rich. **They are excluded.**
- Others are rebelling against Jesus, so for the moment, **they are excluded.**
- Others say there is no God. **They are excluded.**
- Others call The Lord of Hosts a 'she'. **They are excluded.**
- Others are out of order, trying to rule over their households and churches as a woman. **They are excluded.**
- Others use Jesus' name in vain or as a cuss word. **They are excluded.**
- Others appoint themselves as prophets, apostles, bishops and prophetesses, not sent by Jesus. **They are excluded.**
- Others support the LGBTQ agenda. **They are excluded.**
- Others think they know Jesus, but harbour unforgiveness in their hearts. **They are excluded.**
- Others who are proud just KNOW they are going to make it. Jesus hates prideful people, and **they will be excluded.**
- Others just hate Jesus altogether. **They are excluded.**

And we wonder why people are surprised when Jesus says to them - "Go away, I NEVER knew you, you worker of iniquity."

People who have been misled or who are ignorant of how the Lord determines who gets in or who does not are the ones that Jesus is focusing on now. It has been said that Jesus is the God of second chances, and He is trying his best to make sure that everyone makes an informed choice as to where they will spend eternity. The others who hate Jesus and the ones who have no time for Jesus will get their just recompense, as they will be beating on the doors of heaven crying 'I'm sorry!! Let me in!' when they die.

It will be too late then.

For those of you that want to know all you can about salvation know that Jesus will need to clean you up. You will need to put on the new man after taking off the old man. You will need to learn how to walk in that new man, and as you walk, you will produce fruit for the kingdom.



Now you have a basis where you can sit with Jesus and talk about YOU and what He wants for you. Now you know what He is going to take you through. You will be able to get rid of all of the worldly issues you have, plus you will be able to get rid of the things that the devil was using to bind you.

Take this time today to ask the Lord Jesus Christ about what He wants you to nail to your cross so you can die to it and be backfilled with His spirit.

Keep talking to Jesus and He will respond to you. Have Him explain WHY what is being said is true. Talk with the Lord Jesus Christ and get to know Him personally.
